Estimated volume: 33 070 cubic metres.

Term: Two years.

The silviculture systems are clearcut and clearcut with reserves and the harvesting systems are conventional ground skid and overhead cable. Intermediate supports are required on the overhead cable units.

The licencee will be required to deactivate and and grass seed all permanent access structures (PAS) used in this timber sale.

The licencee will be responsible to ensure that landing piles have been clean burned and extinguished as required by the Forest Fire Prevention and Suppression Regulation.

The licencee must participate in the BCTS Environmental Management System (EMS) for this timber sale.

All temporary access structures (TAS) must be completely rehabilitated by the licencee at its own expense.

The licencee must choose to use one of the two laid out forwarding trails for access to Cutpatches 118 and 121 of Block 1. Forwarding trails within Block 1 may not be converted into roads. Cutpatch 121 has an approximate 750-metre skid to the main road.

Upset stumpage rate: The upset stumpage rate was determined by the market pricing system and is applicable only to coniferous green sawlog grades.

Upset stumpage rate for competitive volumes: Timber Mark, 54083; product, sawlog; volume, 33 070 cubic metres; rate, \$33.44 per cubic metre.

Species: Cedar (28%), hemlock (22%), spruce (14%), balsam (14%), Douglas fir (11%), larch (9%) and white pine (2%), more or less.

The preceding volumes are estimates based on statistical samples. Bidders are strongly advised to conduct a thorough field review to verify estimates.
